San Joaquin County Sheriff's Department Jail Industries, is composed of two full production Auto Body and Upholstery Shops. These shops can do just about everything in their field from full body collision repair to a simple car wash. The Upholstery Shop can do complete automotive upholstery, furniture reupholster and refinish as well as any fabric related type of work, i.e. awnings, car covers, custom fire engine hose protective covers etc.

These programs allow the Sheriff's Office tradition of turning inmate idle time into productive labor. The main objective of the program is twofold. One to provide County Jail Inmates an opportunity to participate in learning or honing their skills in these vocational trades, Inmates must apply to participate in the programs, formal interviews are conducted and expectations of performance and proper behavior are made known to the selected participants. The second goal is for the programs to attain financial self sufficiency. This is where the support of other government agencies and non profit organizations becomes necessary as the programs do not compete with private industry nor are any taxpayer monies used.

The managers of these programs are extremely qualified, our pricing is below industry standards but the Quality is second to none.
